





# UC-trained doctors remain in California in high numbers














# Patient Complexity (Case Mix Index) by UC Academic Health Center



(shown in millions of dollars)







# Percentage of Net Patient Service Revenue by Payor














# In-Person Ambulatory and Virtual Care Visits




# Cancer Patient Disease Distribution by AHC
